Interesting cases review meeting held roughly once a month. Audit meetings occur every 2 months. <u>You will be expected to attend these meetings</u>. You are expected to do one audit per year and I would encourage early engagement. Once you are settled in please speak to our audit lead or me to see if there is anything that is of interest. I would also encourage liaising with our excellent clinical departments to establish cross speciality improvement projects.

Consultant tutorials

These will last ½ hour to an hour. These will vary week to week but these are the sessions available. Please check with relevant consultant.

These may vary and I would encourage early discussion with consultants to identify suitable times.

<u>Rotas</u>

There is a weekly rota which is on the main notice board. Your rotas will be individualised to meet curriculum requirements. The allocation of a private study session is discretionary.

Sessions are structured 9-1 pm and 1-5 pm. You will usually be rostered with a consultant. You will have your own US and screening sessions after the first 8 months as a ST1.

Trainees ST3 onwards will have a greater degree of autonomy and will have Duty radiology sessions.

Duty Radiologist

There is a dedicated line that is portable- 4215.

The role of this person is to answer questions from clinical teams and GPs. The complexity of this role has increased so it is generally consultant/more senior ST led. You may be asked to report imaging scans, perform US or fluoroscopy.

<u>On call</u>

On call for STs start from the 3rd attachment as a ST1.

All STs on call will be doing roughly a 1 in 8 rota. In any 4 month block you will mirror the consultants and do 3 sets of weekdays (Monday to Thursday) and 3 sets of weekends (Friday and Saturday only).

We work extended weekdays 5 - 7.30 pm when on call and Saturday is 10-2 pm. (We do work Sundays 10- 2 pm but you are not required to do this). There is always a consultant on site during fixed sessions. After these times teleradiology takes over. There is no commitment to you outside these times.

Leave

6 weeks' notice is required for annual and study leave. Please note that the allocated annual leave for each 4 month block needs to be taken in that block. Leave can only be carried forward after discussion with the college tutor and will only be considered under exceptional circumstances. You are entitled to 30 days study leave per year of which several days are for the KSS study days and the MSC. You can take up to 5-days private study before an examination and on two occasions a year, which will come out of your 30 study leave days. The day of the examination is given as an additional day outside of the 30 days, and you can take this on 2 occasions.
