APPRENTICESHIP ELIGABILITY CRITERIA

In order to undertake an apprenticeship at SASH, once recruited into an entry level post, the following must apply:

- Applicants must be working in an appropriate role to undertake the apprenticeship.
- Hold a contract of employment with the Trust.
- You must have lived in the EU for at least the last three vears.
- Hold a GCSE or equivalent in Maths & English*

*SASH supports and funds existing staff to undertake a Functional Skills GCSE qualification to gain entry to higher qualification

A Learning Journal (reflective self assessment including a portfolio of evidence)



On & Off the Job Training and Ongoing Assessment



Mock Assessments & End Point Assessments

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry requirements will depend on the type and level of apprenticeship.

For example, you may need four or five GCSEs at grades 9-4/A-C or equivalent to do a level 3 apprenticeship. To start a level 5 or 6 apprenticeship you're likely to need A-levels or equivalent level 3 qualifications or relevant and sufficient experience.

WORK EXPERIENCE AT SASH

Surrey & Sussex Healthcare offer a range of opportunities for work experience placements both clinical and non- clinical such as medical placements on wards and clinics or administrative placements at the Trust Headquarters. You will shadow a colleague to gain an understanding of the work environment and explore a potential career path.
