

Accommodation for your Placement at East Surrey Hospital, Redhill

Welcome to A2 Dominion South who manage the accommodation at the East Surrey Hospital site.

Accommodation

The accommodation is non en-suite.

You will be sharing with up to 3 others. **Due to the number of students requiring accommodation we cannot guarantee single sex accommodation and your room is for single occupancy only.**

You are approx. a 2-minute walk from the back of the hospital.

There is a communal kitchen, bathroom and lounge in each flat however there are no TVs provided. Ironing boards, basic cooking utensils etc. are all supplied.

Communal areas are cleaned weekly. Individual bedrooms are not cleaned whilst you are on placement.

You will need to bring the following items for your stay:

A duvet, bed linen for up to a small double bed (some rooms do have single beds so we recommend a flat sheet to guarantee it will fit. You are unable to request bed size), extra towels, washing up liquid, kitchen roll and a tea towel.

Note: Personal belongings are not to be kept in the shared areas of your flat due to health and safety reasons.

There is a launderette on site which is open 24 hours a day for your convenience. You will need to set up an account with Circuit Laundry and use the Circuit app to use these facilities.

Internet

We have Wi-Fi onsite which is free for you to use whilst you are a medical student here at our hospital.

You will need to set up an account and password with the provider GLIDE. Select the glide network on your Wi-Fi settings and follow the instructions. If you have any issues, please contact Glide directly on 0333 123 1190.

Parking

There is no parking available for medical students at the accommodation. You will however be able to access all of the onsite staff car parks (located close to the accommodation) free of charge – you will be emailed further information about the parking facilities available and how to register your vehicle, by the Post Graduate Education Centre, approx. 2 weeks prior to your start date.

There is also a regular bus service from the main entrance of the hospital in the directions of Redhill, Gatwick and Crawley.

Collecting your key – weekends and after the office is closed

Your key will be left in the Ops Centre in the main hospital. The Ops Centre is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and is on the ground floor of the hospital (in the orange zone) between the Post Room and the Doctors' Mess. Please refer to the map, directions and instructions that will be provided to you by the Post Graduate Education Centre.
